PAYMENT POLICIES

Paragon NEVER locks you in. Our billing cycles are comprised of "short" 4 & 6 week billing cycles.

BUT...

TO STOP BILLING...

YOU MUST TELEPHONE OR E-MAIL THE OFFICE.

Otherwise billing will continue.

1. Full payment is due the first class of each billing period.
2. Each year a non-refundable registration fee is required for each student taking part in any programs at Paragon. The registration fee is prorated according to when you enroll. September \$55 January \$40 May \$25
3. All students must be actively enrolled to participate in any programs, shows or make-up classes. An updated credit card is required to be kept on file to be actively enrolled in any program.
4. We do not refund for snow days or closings due to circumstances beyond our control
5. Consideration for additional make-ups will be made for extended illness.
6. Students will not be admitted to class or team practice if their account has a remaining balance exceeding 30 days
7. There is a \$35.00 fee for returned checks and credit card charge backs.
8. Private instruction are specifically scheduled appointments which are reserved at the customer's request. In order to avoid a \$25 inconvenience fee, the office MUST be advised of any missed appointments. Contact the office at: 201-767-6921 OR Customerservice@paragongym.com

F.A.Q.

Proper Attire

Active wear, clothing that will not restrict movement. Leotards, shorts with t-shirt, warm-up pants with t-shirt are acceptable. Long hair must be tied back. No belts, no jeans, no jewelry, no dresses, no tights or socks.

Snow Days

Paragon will only be closed if the Norwood Police advises that traveling is unsafe. Paragon will e-mail our customers of any closings or delayed openings. You can also check our website, or telephone us to hear a recorded message about any closings or delayed openings. Please contact us to schedule your make-up and time.

Make-Up Classes

Make-Ups are given for absence and for missed classes due to snow days, inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances beyond our control. You must be enrolled to participate in a make-up class. WE DO NOT credit or refund for any missed classes. Missed classes must be made-up within 6 weeks of the absence. All make-ups expire at the start of the summer session and cannot be rolled over to the next school year. Additional make-ups or scheduling consideration can be arranged for extended illness, or extenuating circumstances. Please contact the office for details.

Injuries

Any child returning to Paragon after an injury or surgery should submit a Doctor's note. This very important policy is in our student's best interest, but is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian. Please always check with your doctor and explain about movements specific to gymnastics such as rotating upside down, landing impact, stretching, cardio, and strength movement before you allow your child to return.

Illness

To ensure that your child feels well enough to participate in class safely, please do NOT send your child to class if they are displaying any signs of illness or lethargy. If your child is coughing, sneezing, has a sinus infection *ie. Green mucus*, they should not attend class. If your child is acting in a lethargic manner from a headache, lack of sleep or is experiencing other concerns, they should NOT participate in class.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are scheduled through the office. Times are limited. Each student must be registered and have paid the registration fee before beginning lessons. A 24-hour notification to cancel a private lesson that has been scheduled with a coach is required to avoid being billed a \$25 inconvenience fee.

SPECIAL EVENTS

Paragon offers four (4) special events each year.

Showtime

Students perform gymnastics routines on each apparatus, and receive a trophy, keychain photo & flowers. Family and friends are invited into our gym for the annual show. For actively enrolled students ONLY. Showtime is usually scheduled in session 7. Dates and fees announced months in advance. Show registration is first come first served basis.

Panther's Meet

The Panther Team competes "In House" here at Paragon. This is a perfect opportunity for friends and families to come see the team showcase their talents. Meet is held in the spring. Dates and fees announced months in advance.

Ninja Challenge

The end of the season Ninja Challenge is held in the spring. The date and time is announced approximately two months in advance. This is a special event when friends and family are welcome to attend and support each Ninja as they demonstrate their skills and receive a trophy for all their hard work and achievements they have accomplished all year!

Student Award Week

Students receive a medal, in Olympic fashion, 15 minutes prior to the end of class, for all their hard work throughout the year. Must be an actively-enrolled student to participate in Award Week: Usually scheduled the 2nd week of June and announced months in advance.
